# MINUTES OF BURN PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 28.03.2024 STARTING AT 19:00 IN BURN METHODIST CHAPEL SCHOOLROOM

#### 032401. Welcome

- i. The Chairman welcomed all present to the meeting, introduced PH and asked members if they would agree to agenda item 032413, Christmas lights, being discussed here. All members **agreed**.
